Vineyard Notes

Baco Noir grapes sourced from Doyle

Vineyards on the west side of Keuka Lake.

Fermentation & Aging

11 days of skin contact before pressing
grapes. Open top fermenters. Aged 21
months in neutral French oak.

Tasting Notes

A nearly opaque ruby wine with blue
tones, this Baco shoots from the glass
with abundant aromas of bramble, juniper,
raisin, black currant and earthy tones. It is
medium to full bodied with bracing acidity
and modest tannins, leading to a long fruit
driven finish.

Food Pairing Suggestions

This wine is similar to an Italian wine with big
acids. Pair with tomato sauces and medium
meats like veal. It would also be stunning with a
spaghetti Bolognese topped with fresh shaved
parmigiana reggiano.
