


Heron Hill Winery

Appellation: Finger Lakes

Fermentation and aging: Stainless steel.

No malolactic fermentation.

Vineyard notes: Blend of grapes from three sites; Keuka Lake, Seneca Lake, and Cayuga Lake.

WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Citrus aromas are present in this bright unoaked Chardonnay. The lively acidity shines through and allows the wine to linger on the palate with notes of green apple and lemon.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This wine perfectly accents shrimp scampi or seared scallops with simple seasoning. It also complements chicken in a butter herb sauce. For a cheese pairing ~ try with nutty semi-soft cheese, or Asiago.
