WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Tropical fruit and citrus aromas are present in this refreshing unoaked Chardonnay. The lively acidity shines through and allows the wine to linger on the palate with notes of green apple, lime and banana.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This wine perfectly accents shrimp scampi or seared scallops with simple seasoning. It also complements chicken in a butter herb sauce. For a cheese pairing – try with nutty semi-soft cheese, or Asiago.
