


Heron Hill Winery 2014 INGLE VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Bright cherry aromas with subtle smoky and leather notes, light-bodied Pinot Noir with good structure. Aeration reveals ripe fruit flavors such as strawberry and plum. Nature-friendly viticulture practices enhance this wine's personality, all grapes were hand-harvested.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Enjoy this wine with a variety of cured meat such as prosciutto and sopressata. It will also complement grilled salmon on a cedar plank very well. For a cheese pairing, try with semi-sharp to sharp cheeses such as Comté, or even a mild cow milk blue cheese like Blue d'Auvergne.
