WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Elegant and lively, this reserve wine is made from exceptional grapes grown at a site with abundant sun exposure situated on the west side of Seneca Lake. Lemongrass and a hint of limestone are immediately present on the nose. Then the bouquet fills with tropical fruit aromas like star fruit, papaya, grapefruit and mango. At first the wine is round and supple on the palate, liveliness develops on the mid-palate and the wine finishes with green apple notes.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This medium-body, smooth wine compliments flavorful dishes like Thai mussels or clams in white wine sauce. It is also a pleasing accompaniment to poultry dishes like roasted chicken with mushroom cream sauce. For a cheese pairing, try with Manchego.
