Vineyard Notes

Appellation: Finger Lakes

Baco Noir grapes sourced from Doyle Vineyards on the west side of Keuka Lake.

Fermentation & Aging

10 days of skin contact before pressing grapes. Aged 20 months in French oak

Tasting Notes

A nearly opaque ruby wine with blue tones, this Baco has abundant aromas of bramble, raisin, black currant and earthy tones. It is medium to full bodied with fresh acidity leading to a long fruit driven finish.

Food Pairing Suggestions

This wine pairs well with rare red meats and wild game meats like venison. Powerful and refreshing all at once, with the intensity of aromas could also work well with a rich Pho.
