Fermented 10 days on the skins then pressed after skin contact. Aged 21 months in Neutral French oak.

This wine is all about elegance and complexity. Intense aromatics of violets, cherry, strawberry and earthy beet roots. The palate is medium bodied with fresh acids and silky tannins. With wonderful floral and red fruit character and a medium length finish
