


Heron Hill Winery 2016 INGLE VINEYARD RIESLING

WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Characteristically Riesling aromas of flint with delicate tropical notes. This wine reveals fruit flavors of ripe apples and lemon, followed by a clean finish with refreshing acidity. Nature-friendly viticulture practices enhance this wine's personality, all grapes were hand-harvested.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This wine is a perfect match with raw oysters. Also enjoy with sautéed German sausages with bacon and apple sauerkraut. For a cheese pairing, try a young cheddar or Manchego.
