WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Elegant and lively, this reserve wine is made from exceptional grapes grown at a site with abundant sun exposure situated on the west side of Seneca Lake. Tropical fruit, pear, grapefruit, and floral notes fill the bouquet. The well-balanced palate has some minerality, with hints of white plum and nectarine, and lively acidity on the finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This refined and refreshing wine complements grilled light white fish, and raw shellfish.
For a cheese pairing, try with Manchego or fresh coat cheese & herbs.
